The Coleopterist's Newsletter

At a Coleopterist's meeting at Monks Wood Experimental Station in May 1980 it was suggested that an association of Coleopterists might be established. Although this idea never materialised, Jonathan Cooter launched *The Coleopterist's Newsletter* in August 1980. This was originally circulated to about 50 subscribers, most of whom had attended the Monks Wood meeting. The list of subscribers gradually increased and there were almost 200 when the final newsletter was published in November 1991.

The Coleopterist

This is the successor to the Coleopterist's Newsletter and was first published in March 1992. Each volume covers one calendar year and consists of three A5 booklets. It is devoted to all aspects of the scientific study of British and Irish Coleoptera and Strepsiptera. Howard Mendel, was editor for the first three volumes, then early in 1995 he handed over the duty to Dr Andrew Duff. The current editor is Tony Allen who took over in 2002.
